An Intermediate Repair Technician will have following skills/responsibilities:

- At least one year of experience repairing surgical instruments or similar products
- Work under minimal supervision from the Master Repair Technician
- Receiving and decontamination of incoming surgical instruments
- Preparing instruments for the repair process, taping for color coding etc.
- Acid etching and other instrument marking
- Removal of insulation and or previous color coding
- Packaging and shipment of repaired instruments back to customers
- Refinishing of instruments, matte, satin, polished, bead blasting
- Buffing, polishing, and sharpening of general sharps (e.g. Scissors, osteotomes, curettes etc.).
- Repairing basic hinged instruments
- Replacing carbide inserts and gold dipping
- Nylon colour coding of instruments
- Cautery Cord repair
- Silver Soldering
- Other various tasks as request by the Master Repair Technician or General Manager

A Senior Repair Technician would have a minimum of five years experience repairing surgical instruments or similar products and would be expected to work independently and without supervision.
